



After compiling 5,146 passing yards and 107 touchdowns for the Iron in Milwaukee in 2010, the Dallas Cowboys (NFL) QB Chris Greisen set.

After the Cowboys Tony Romo injured reserve list on December 21, 2010, Greisen was signed to the practice squad on December 27, 2010. Greisen was activated on December 31, 2010.

Greisen finished the 2010 season with the Milwaukee Iron AFL edge in total offense (5,156 yards), passing total (5,146 meters) and pass efficiency (0.679). After the season, Greisen Florida signed the Tuskers. Greisen spent five seasons in the AFL (2005-10), two in the UFL (2009-10), one in the AF2 (2004), and one in NFL Europe (2003). Arizona Cardinals drafted Greisen in the seventh-round pick in 1999 from the NFL. From 1999-01, Greisen was a member of the Cardinals and finished 7-of-16 passes for 69 yards and a touchdown in service in place. In 2002, Greisen was released after training camp and signed with the Washington Redskins.
